Published admission appeals timeline for September 2021

If your child was not offered a place at Limehurst Academy on the National Offer day (1 March 2021), you have the right to appeal this decision, to an independent appeals panel.

How to lodge an appeal	<p>Visit our website and complete the 'Notice of Appeal' form: https://www.limehurst.org.uk/appeals</p> <p>Or download a copy and return via email to: aparker@limehurst.org.uk</p> <p>Via post to: Admissions Department, Limehurst Academy, Bridge Street, Loughborough LE11 1NH</p> <p>You will need to return your completed Notice of Appeal by Monday 26th April 2021 (10am). Appeals received after this deadline will be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals, where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged with the school.</p>
The appeal hearing	<p>For applications made in the normal admissions round, our appeals will be held in two stages:</p> <p><u>Stage 1 - School's case</u></p> <p>Monday 10th May - All parents who have lodged an appeal will be emailed a copy of the school's case with a link to a questionnaire, which will give an opportunity to ask questions. The form must be returned before Thursday 20th May at 10am.</p> <p>The Presenting Officer will answer all the questions submitted by the appellants and the panel. The responses will be emailed to all appellants and the panel members.</p> <p>Friday 4th June - Panel review the case and make a decision on whether to uphold the school's case. This decision will be confirmed by email, once received from the Clerk. Provided the independent appeals panel is satisfied that prejudice has been proven, your individual appeal will now take place via zoom or written communication.</p> <p><u>Stage 2 - Parent's case (14th-16th June 2021)</u></p> <p>Stage 2 Individual appeal hearings will now take place via a zoom meeting. Parents will be given the date and time of their individual appeal no less than 10 days before the hearing. If you are a keyworker with time restrictions, please advise details on the form at Stage 1.</p> <p>If you do not have the access to technology, we can organise for you to attend the school and use a meeting room with access to a laptop. Alternatively, your appeal will be conducted using the written evidence that you have provided, any further evidence can be submitted by email prior to the appeal.</p>
Appeal outcome	Parents will be notified, in writing, by Wednesday 23rd June 2021
