NEW TERM ARRANGEMENTS

BUBBLES

- It is no longer necessary to keep children in consistent groups ('bubbles'). This means bubbles will not need to be used in schools from the autumn term.

ISOLATION

- From 16 August 2021, children under the age of 18 years old will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are contacted by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case.

FACE COVERINGS

- Face coverings will no longer be advised for students, staff and visitors either in classrooms or in communal areas. They will remain optional for those who choose to wear them.

UNIFORM

- Students should come in full school uniform each day. The changing rooms will be in use for PE, so there is no need for children to come to school in their PE kit.
