Year 11 Mock Examinations

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that your child will take mock examinations during the weeks beginning November 14th and 21st. Attached to this letter is a copy of the timetable for all exams taking place during those weeks. Subject teachers will be providing students with details of which content to revise in preparation for the exams. After half term all students will receive an individual exam timetable, giving details of rooms and seat numbers for the exams they are involved in.

For morning exams, registration will take place in form rooms, and students will go to their exam rooms at 9:00am. For afternoon exams, students will go to their exam rooms at the end of lunch at 2:00pm.

Students are not able to start exams late or leave exams early. Therefore, we would appreciate your assistance in helping to make sure your child arrives at school promptly in the morning. Please also take note that most afternoon exams are more than one hour in length, and so on these occasions, your child will remain at school after 3:00pm until their exam has finished.

Students are reminded to bring the correct equipment - black pens, pencils, eraser, sharpener, ruler, scientific calculator (unless prohibited) and a maths set (for maths exams) in a clear pencil case. Students may bring a drink of water into the exam room, but this must be in a clear bottle without a label. Students must also wear the correct school uniform. Mobile phones, watches and any other electronic devices must not be on or near students during an exam.

We are fully expecting that the Summer 2023 GCSE exams and other formal assessments will go ahead as planned. However, in the unlikely event that the exams next summer do not take place, then the results of the November mock exams would be used as one part of the evidence to decide final grades.
