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## **Key Stage Four Options Process**

Dear Parent / Carer,

We are now at the point in Year 9 where we would like students to make some choices about the subjects they will be studying in Years 10 and 11.

We have dedicated a section of the school website to helping you and your child making informed choices. This can be found <u>here.</u> On the website page there is an introductory video, explaining the options process, the Options Booklet and video presentations for each qualification.

Your child has been placed on **Pathway A**, meaning that they will study nine qualifications at Key Stage Four. The detail behind this is explained in both the Options Booklet and in the introductory video about making options choices.

We want students to take time to consider their options choices. Over the course of the next few weeks, in Personal Development and in subject lessons, teachers will work with students to help them decide which courses they would like to follow.

We are holding an <u>online</u> Parents' Evening on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March where you can make video appointments to discuss your child's progress in English, Maths and Science and also where you can talk to teachers of the optional subjects your child is considering for next year. We recommend that you and your child attend the online appointments together.

The school has introduced a new, easy to use online appointment booking system. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments. You will be able to book five minute video appointments. If you would like to talk to a member of staff about a SEND or pastoral matter, please contact school separately.

Appointments can be made from 9am on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> February and will close on 6<sup>th</sup> March. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office.

Please visit <u>SchoolCloud - Limehurst Academy</u> to book your appointments. This <u>link</u> gives further information about how to use the video call system. Please note that you will need to be on each call at the exact time booked.
