NEU Strike Action, Thursday 27th April & Tuesday 2nd May 2023

Dear Parent/Carer,

The next strike by NEU members is due to take place on two days over the next two weeks, Thursday 27th April & Tuesday 2nd May. As before, this action is not against the school itself but is part of national industrial action organised by this trade union about pay, workload and school funding.

Under trade union law, staff are not required to tell me of their intention to strike and furthermore, I am not allowed to direct non-striking staff to cover for striking colleagues. Based on the information that I have received, it will not be possible to operate as normal on those days. This decision is based on safety grounds, as there will not be enough staff to supervise the students.

Years 7, 8, 9 & 10 students should stay at home on Thursday 27th April & Tuesday 2nd May. Where your child's teacher is not striking, there will be work set on Teams, according to their normal timetables for those days. Work will not be set where your child's teacher is striking, but some suggested activities that your child can do are on the next page of this letter.

Year 11 students will have some lessons in school. Exact times will be confirmed in another letter when timetables have been finalised. This letter will be given directly to students next week.

I understand that this will be a great inconvenience to many of you, but is unavoidable.

If your child is in Years 7-10, and is normally in receipt of a free school meal, you can order a packed lunch for collection by completing this <u>form</u>. The meal will then be ready to collect between 11.00am and 12.00pm on the day.

We must all hope that the issues over which the industrial action has arisen are resolved as soon as possible.
