Year 11 Update

Dear Parent/Carer,

The week beginning 24th May marks the final week in school for our year 11 cohort. As our subject areas reach the point where the evidence needed to assign grades has been collected, year 11 students will have a reduced timetable next week:

Monday 24th May – Thursday 27th May: students will be in school from 10:00am until 3:00pm, rather than until 3:45pm. They will attend lessons from 10:00am until 2:45pm as usual. At 2:45pm they will go to Lesson 6 for fifteen minutes only, to allow for the signing of subject evidence declarations, and to ensure that we stay COVID compliant with the staggered dismissal of students at the end of the school day.

Friday 28th May: students should arrive at school as usual at 10:00am and go to their lesson. During this time they will complete a final declaration about the evidence being used for their Teacher Assessed Grades. They will also receive information about transition to post 16 providers, and about the results and appeals process in August. It is important that all students attend this session.

The majority of students will then have completed all of their work and **will be allowed to leave school at 11:00am**. Students taking Art, 3D Design and Textiles, who have not completed their assessments, will remain in school until 1:15pm. Students will have been informed if this applies to them.
