Dear Parent/Carer

Firstly, we would like to thank you for your support with the re-opening of our school. It is great to have all students back at Limehurst and learning again.

As the vast majority of transmission of coronavirus takes place indoors, it is essential that we continue to ensure that our buildings are well ventilated. Because of this, government guidance states that we must keep the doors and windows of our classrooms open. Students will not be able to wear any extra outerwear in lessons. Consequently, as the weather gets increasingly cold, they will need to wear additional layers underneath their school shirt such as a white vest, t-shirt or an under-armour style top. Students must continue to wear their Limehurst jumper, cardigan and/or blazer. Please remember that hoodies are not allowed in school.

Students in years 7 to 10 will carry on wearing their Limehurst PE kit on the days that they have practical PE. To stay warm, they should either wear additional layers underneath their PE top (as above) or wear a Limehurst jumper, cardigan or blazer on top of their blue PE top.
