Year 11 Update

Dear Parent / Carer

We continue to be really pleased with the way in which our year 11 students are managing the exam season. Thank you once again for all you are doing to support your child during this period.

For the remainder of this week, students are expected to attend school full time, including attending all lessons when they are not exams.

From **Monday 13th June onwards**, students will only need to attend school for examinations.

Morning exams

Where a student has a morning exam, they should arrive as usual and go to registration before attending their exam.

After a morning exam, students will leave school immediately. This includes students who have both morning and afternoon exams on the same day.

Afternoon exams

Where a student has an afternoon exam, and they would like to be served a school dinner, they should arrive at 1:15pm via Reception and go to the Dining Room.

For students who do not want a school dinner, they should arrive at 1:30pm via the Sports Hall gate.

All students must be on site by 1:40pm, ready for a prompt exam start at 1:45pm.

Live online lessons and exam resources will be provided on Microsoft Teams to help students prepare for the final exams. Live online lessons will be scheduled when students would normally have a lesson in a subject where there are still exams to take place and will be scheduled in students' Teams Calendars.

Once again, thank you for your support. I will write to you again, later this month, with details of GCSE Results Day, which is on Thursday 25th August.
