Use the Present tense and the Futur Proche to use 3 tenses. Focus: Accurate use of Perfect Tense rules, Using AVOIR and ÊTRE.</p>	<p>Year 9 1. Les émissions à la télé Talking about television programmes. Opinions. Describe a character in a French TV programme. Revisit: Adjectives. BAGS Focus: Understanding authentic French television programmes. Using visual clues to understand unknown vocabulary.</p>	
	<p>5. En vacances Describe what you normally do on holiday and what you are going to do on holiday next year. Revisit: Infinitives. Add interest – 5Ws: When, where, who, what, why. Focus: Extend your use of the Present tense and start to learn a future tense. Stretch: Use present and future tenses together.</p>	
<p>3. Mes loisirs Extend your work from ‘Les sports’ to describe what you do in your leisure time. Use more VERBS! Add interest (5Ws) and communicate your own ideas about yourself and other people. Use extension language structures, such as aimer + infinitive. Focus: Revisiting Present Tense rules. Using a greater number of verbs in the Present tense.</p>	<p>4. Quel temps fait-il? The weather! Extend your knowledge of geography in French. You can use the work in this topic to add more interest in future topics. Focus: il y a + weather, il fait + weather and quand.</p>	
<p>2. Ma zone Describe your local area. Using more interesting language, such as ‘il y a’ and ‘on peut + infinitive’. Revisit: 5Ws: Where, what, who and why. Focus: Describe a picture. PALM</p>
