

Key Stage 4 Spanish GCSE Road Map – (Edexcel)

Spanish GCSE - Edexcel Board.	
Students take four examinations at the end of the course, in the summer term of Year 11. Speaking, listening, reading and writing skills are examined in separate examinations.	
Module 1	<p>Thematic contexts: Media and technology and My personal world.</p> <p>¡Diviértete! Your life online. Saying how you stay active. What you watch on television. Going out. What you have done last weekend. Grammar focus: Present tense. Future Tense. Past tense. Opinions and reasons.</p>
Module 2	<p>Thematic context: Travel and tourism.</p> <p>Viajes. Talking about holidays, including travel plans, destinations, accommodation and activities. Spanish festivals. Grammar: Reinforcing tenses. Comparatives. Opinions in the past. Use 'if'.</p>
Module 3	<p>Thematic context: Media and technology and My personal world.</p> <p>Mi gente, mi mundo. Describing people- appearances and personalities. Discussing friendships and relationships. Discussing social media. Talking about problems and giving advice. Grammar: Reinforcing the preterite tense. Reflexive verbs. Possessive adjectives.</p>
Module 4	<p>Thematic context: Lifestyle and wellbeing.</p> <p>Mi Estilo de vida. Discussing food. Healthy and unhealthy daily routines. Discussing good mental health. Describing illnesses and accidents. Comparing old and new habits. Grammar: Reinforcing tenses. Using the 'if' clause. Using commands.</p>
Module 5	<p>Thematic context: Studying and my future.</p> <p>¡A clase! Talking about a typical school day, including subjects. Opinions and reasons. How you would change your school. Describing a past school trip. Grammar: Giving opinions and reasons. Reinforcing adjectives. Using the conditional tense. Reinforcing negatives.</p>
Module 6	<p>Thematic context: My neighbourhood</p> <p>Mi barrio y yo. Describing cities. Giving directions. Discussing shopping preferences. Describe where you live. Giving opinions about where you live, including the climate. Grammar: Reinforcing tenses. Prepositions. Direct object pronouns.</p>
Module 7	<p>Thematic context: My neighbourhood</p> <p>Un mundo mejor para todos. Talking about how you help in your community. Environmentally friendly habits. Discussing social and climate issues. Grammar: Reinforcing the present and preterite tenses. Reinforcing different subject pronouns in different tenses.</p>
Module 8	<p>Thematic context: Studying and my future.</p> <p>El futuro te espera. Talking about future plans, hopes and career paths. Giving advice. Giving opinions about the importance of learning languages. Discussing artificial intelligence. Grammar focus: Extending the range of tenses still further. Using modal verbs. Broadening the vocabulary knowledgebase.</p>
