### Limehurst Transition Information

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to be able to tell you that we have allocated students to a tutor group for their time at Limehurst Academy. This process has been done working in collaboration with your child's primary school and we have made every effort to ensure that they are placed in a tutor group with at least one of their friends, where appropriate. Students will generally stay with the same form tutor throughout their journey at Limehurst Academy, but we will continually monitor the effectiveness of these groups and make changes if we feel appropriate for students' education.

Students will register with their tutor every morning, as well as completing a variety of academic and organisational tasks to help prepare them for the day ahead. Your child's form tutor is their first point of contact for any help and support they need at school.

From August, as well as providing pastoral care, form tutors also deliver one lesson of Personal Development to their tutor group every Monday morning. Students will follow their own specific timetable each day. In some subject's students are taught as a tutor group, but in many departments the tutor groups are mixed to ensure that the level and pace of learning in that subject matches students' needs best. Therefore, students will have the opportunity to work collaboratively with a wide range of their peers throughout the school, helping them to develop communication, teamwork, and other social skills.

#### New Parents Evening

To support a successful transition to secondary school, we would like to invite you to a Parents' Evening on **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026 (6:00-7:00pm)**. Throughout the evening you will have the opportunity to learn more about the organisation of the school and to discuss any concerns you may have. The

evening will commence with an introductory talk at 6.00pm by the Headteacher, Mr Mellor, and we would ask that you arrive by **5.45pm**. You will also have the opportunity to meet your child's the Head of Year, Mr Jones, and form tutors, who will be able to answer any questions you may have. Students are encouraged to attend with you.

### **Induction Days**

To aid with the transition process we would also like to make you aware that we shall be holding two induction days to help to familiarise your child with our school. Our induction days are on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July and Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2026**.

On the induction days, we would like all students to **arrive between 8:30am and 8:40am via the Tatmarsh entrance to the school**. Due to the current warm weather, we have allowed our existing students to wear their PE kit for comfort, and we would like to extend the same option to our incoming Year 7 students. Students may therefore attend in either their usual primary school uniform or their school's PE kit, whichever they feel most comfortable wearing. There is **no need to bring additional PE kit**, regardless of which option they choose. Students will be dismissed at **3:10pm** from the Tatmarsh gates. Please ensure any necessary arrangements are made for their safe journey home.
