

Medicine Calling Careers Event for Years 10 and 11 – helping students choose the right A-levels

We are holding a careers evening on Wednesday 25th April 2018 at Leicester Medical School, University of Leicester, for students who have an interest in Medicine or Psychology, and are interested in finding out more about Psychiatry.

Psychiatry is a branch of medicine where doctors treat people with mental illness and would appeal to students interested in people, medicine and mental health. Psychiatrists study medicine at university, rather than psychology, and then specialise in psychiatry when they are junior doctors. We are keen to target students who are considering their A-Levels options that would either lead to studying medicine or psychology at University. The University of Leicester (along with many others) is now accepting Psychology A-Level as one of the sciences needed to apply for undergraduate medicine, so we are keen to make students aware of this so that they choose the right options for their post-16 choices.
