

Transition to Limehurst Academy 2020 Key Staff




Mr Mellor - Headteacher

Mr Lakhani - Assistant Headteacher




Mrs Hirji - Form Tutor of 7HI

As well as being a form tutor, I teach PE so I obviously love sport!



Mrs Brierley - Pupil Support Manager


I lead the pupil support team.

Mrs Chauhan - EAL Coordinator


I work with students who speak English as a second language. I help to make sure that they are able to make good progress in their subjects.
